Building Committee (Advisory Board?) Charter

<u>Purpose</u>: To act as an advisory board to the full Masconomet SC on Capital Improvement projects at Masconomet Regional

Committee Membership

- The building committee shall consist of the four DCI/Capital subcommittee members, the Masconomet Superintendent, the Masconomet Assistant Superintendent and (3/6) community members (1/2) from each of the three member towns (Boxford, Middleton & Topsfield).
- Committee Chair? Same as DCI/Budget?

Meeting Cadence

- Committee meetings will take place during regular school hours
- Meetings will be held at Masconomet Regional
- Expected cadence of meetings will generally be once a month, during the school year (additional meetings or adjustments to schedule can be made as the committee chair deems necessary

Community Member Selection Process and Term Length

- Nomination for community members shall be solicited via communication with local town government members and announcements made via regular school committee meetings, superintendent communications and appropriate social media channels
- Interested people must submit a completed application form to Masco DCI/Budget subcommittee chair or the Masco School Committee chair
- Community members shall be chosen based on a review of candidates' qualifications and a vote
 of the four DCI/Capital subcommittee members. Candidates must be approved by three out of
 the four SC members
- Terms for community members will be one year in length, coinciding with the standard year long calendar of the Masconomet School Committee
- Community member positions will be filled as soon as the Masco SC names the DCI/Budget subcommittee members (generally this occurs in May for the upcoming school year).
- Open positions during the year can be filled any time a suitable candidate applies and is accepted

Voting Rights for Committee Recommendations

- Each SC member shall have one vote on any recommendations to the SC
- Each member town will have one vote on any recommendations to the SC
 - If there is one community member from a particular town, that member shall have a full vote
 - If there are two community member from a particular town, each shall have ½ of a vote
 - In cases where two members from the same town disagree, that town's vote will be considered an abstention
