SEASONAL GOLF CART RULES AND REGULATIONS

- (1) All Golf Carts must have liability insurance at a minimum amount of \$100,000. Proof of liability insurance must be provided with initial registration and renewal.
- (2) Only 1 Golf Cart permitted Per Seasonal Site.
- (3) All Campground Road Signs and Posted Speed Limits Apply. Golf Carts must stay on roads, designated golf cart paths and parking areas. Golf Carts must also follow the same rules of the park roads as automobiles. (Speed Limit 5 MPH and follow one ways)
- (4) No Reckless Driving.
- (5) No Political Flag, Stickers, or Treasures. No profanity or inappropriate markings of any kind. (Nothing Controversial)
- (6) Golf Carts must be parked in designated parking areas when visiting the pool and common areas. Do not block walkways, paths, or roadways. Golf

Carts are not permitted in the front parking lot. Golf Carts may not go past the security gate. (only in case of emergency)

(7) You are responsible for your Golf Cart at all times.

(8) Only 18+ seasonal site contracted campers with a valid drivers license are permitted to drive a Golf Cart.

(9) No Drinking Alcohol while Driving. Do not operate if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

(10) No loud music or horns of any kind are permitted except for a campground organized Golf Cart parade. You may play music that is appropriate at a reasonable volume, but we do not permit loud air horns. These loud air horns not only frighten people and pets, they are extremely obnoxious to other guests. Keep the noise level low. Be respectful of fellow campers in the park.

(11) All 18+ drivers must be on your seasonal site contract and registered in the office. They must be listed as an insured driver on your Golf Cart Policy.

(12) No hanging off the cart or off the back. Please use Golf Cart seating as intended. All occupants must always be seated in a seat and wearing seat belts (If equipped). No children on the driver's lap while operating.

(13) Approach turns slowly and with caution. Watch out for children, families, and pets on bikes, walking and watch out for other cars and golf carts. Pull to the side and let others pass you.

(14) Do not operate without park/campground approval. Registration, proof of insurance, and contract must be on file.

(15) Remove keys when the cart is not in use or left unattended.

(16) Do not exceed the manufacturer specs for the number of occupants. (4-seater seats 4 people only no more). We do not allow 6 Person Golf Carts.

(17) Use headlights and turn signals (if equipped) when driving at night. Must have working headlights.

(18) Golf Carts must remain on their registered site during quiet hours. 12am - Sunrise. No Golf Cart riding through the park after midnight or before sunrise. Only under extreme circumstances will this be permitted. ie: to escort an ambulance into the park for a medical emergency. "Management would still need to be notified"

(19) Registered Golf Carts will be plugged in for charging into your own metered site electric box. (Seasonal pays for electricity) We suggest plugging in at night when its cooler.

(20) Any infraction of rules will be reviewed and if necessary privileges may be revoked and under extreme circumstances ejected from the park with NO REFUND.

(21) Golf Cart operators must follow the full list of rules found here on the Golf Cart Rules, and on your seasonal contract.

(22) The Golf Cart must be in good working order. No "Modified" or "Lifted" carts allowed without prior office approval. A photo must be provided prior to being brought into the park. (It is recommended that you check with the office before purchasing a new Golf cart to be sure it meets criteria.)

(23) All Golf Carts must be numbered on both sides with the owners site number in 4" Numbers.

(24) Permanent Shelters or garages of any kind for Golf Carts are expressly prohibited. Fabric Golf Cart Covers are allowed.

(25) Resort Camplands Int. DBA Stateline Campresort & Cabins is not liable for any damage to Golf Carts, Including but not limited to, any loss, injury, or damage caused by said Golf Cart.

(26) This seasonal privilege of allowing Golf Carts is on a trial basis. If the rules are not adhered to by the majority, this privilege can and will be revoked. Your purchasing your Golf Cart is at your own free will. There is no guarantee this benefit will be available in the future.

(27) Management Reserves the right to amend or modify these rules as deemed necessary (at any time).
