 - Students are sending in a lot of feedback to review
- University is reaffirming we are 1 school, three campuses. Will have a central community and sub committee per campus in admissions.
- Tuition allocation-possible to better track department allocations
 - Will see changes, but haven't yet
 - Changes in reimbursement possible

Betsy Murray reported on Clinical Immersion Build.

- Clinical Immersion- scheduled after 7-week dedicated Step 1 period, 1 week bridge, then move in March (2nd yr) in Clinical Immersion.
 - Remain the same-Required Clerkships
 - One change-Surgery will move back to 8 weeks
 - 3 periods of flex/electives- increase in outpatient exposure
 - Longitudinal design, continuity design not preferred design
 - Decided on Immersive Design and we will bring it to the committee once it is decided

Discussion:

- Are all students doing surgery 2-options 1. Subspecialty 2. Outpatient Surgery
- This is a great move
- Change takes effect for the Class of 2027 (April/May 2025)
- Finalizing Step 2 Strategy
 - Also adding U World in curricular components

2023 Graduation Questionnaire overview

Claudio Violato presented the GQ, which is done annually by the AAMC. The graduating class of 2023 is who filled out this particular questionnaire. The students were MS1s in 2019-2020 during the pandemic, so keep in mind as we go through this.

- Last 3 years close to national average
- LCME status report:
 - Element 9.4 -we had been cited, with monitoring, the data shows improvement and we were told it is no longer needing monitoring
 - Element 9.7, clerkship feedback, cited as unsatisfactory, we had serious improvement, now we are upgraded to satisfactory with continued monitoring.
 - Continued improvement and will continue to work on these

- Student mistreatment: 53% compared to other questions had reported mistreatment, still need to work on this.
- Study space-improvement overall
- Career planning-good improvements

Action ideas: continue to monitor clerkship observation feedback, continue to implement SERVE curriculum (started on that), continue to attempt to decrease mistreatment.

Jeff Chipman said Joe Oppedisano is working on the dashboard, we need to add a mistreatment question on it.

- LCME limited site visit, gave us 10 elements to follow:
 - 6 unsatisfactory with monitoring, 4 satisfactory

We submitted a response and we received a response from the LCME:

- Only 3 elements with satisfactory with monitoring, they want to make sure consistency in the fix, so will need to report back in December of 2024.

Discussion:

- Grading system to pass/no pass: did the change make a difference?
- Processes that started in 2016/17, hiring UME support, seeing fruitfulness now, now have assessment team to build dashboards- Big shout out for all this work
- The data shows the test scores have improved.
