Eligibility-

- Open for students who are currently enrolled in universities, colleges and schools.
 Additionally, the students graduating after 2023 can participate.
- 1 to 4 people can be in a team. Cross-university/college/school team formation is allowed.

Rules

- Projects must have a significant impact within their respective categories.
- Each team has to bring at least a standard sized X-Banner (5.25 feet x 2 feet). You can bring additional banners for your group if you want. But when you fit those banners, they should be inside the perimeter of your stall/(the space given to you by the competition management)

- Each team has to show/present their project to the judges.
- The winners and runners -up will be decided based on the marks given by the judges.
- You have to bring all the necessary components for your project. If you need
 additional components like extension cord, charging adapter, battery, battery charger
 or any other that is related to your project, the competition management team will not
 provide that.
- The organiser reserves the right to change competition prizes and/or modifies the rules and regulations of the competition as and when necessary,with/without prior notice.
- If you have any problem about these rules then please contact the competition management team.
- Any kind of misconduct with anyone will result in immediate disqualification from the competition.
- Participants are required to submit a project description during registration. The event organizers will review submissions to determine eligibility for the showcase. If a project is deemed ineligible, the registration will be cancelled and the registration fee refunded.

Judging Criteria

- Is the project impactful? Does it solve any real world problems? (0 is the lowest impactful, 10 is the highest impactful)
- Is the project innovative? Is there any other similar concept that is similar to it? (0 is for ideas that exists, 10 is truly novel ides)
- Did you complete the project properly? (0 project is still just an idea. 10 project is completed and brought here to show the judges)
- How close your project is to the problem to the solution/idea you provided? (0 is far away from the concept you provided. 10 The project properly represents the idea participants provided)
