PLAYERS DIVISION

Boys 13-15 & 16-18 yrs Girls 13-15 & 16 & 18 yrs

This division is designed for boys and girls 13-18 years who are ready for a higher level of competitive junior golf. Players in this division demonstrate strong skills, confidence on the course and a commitment to improving their game.

Recommended for players of the appropriate age who have played at this level in previous WNYPGA Jr Tour seasons or come to the Tour with a solid background in the following:

- Player can play in an 18-hole or 36-hole event walking while carrying/pushing their clubs with ease
- Players in this division scoring average ranges 72 to 100.
- Player can compete independently, without help from caddy, spectator or coach
- Player has a solid understanding of USGA Rules and is comfortable when ruling situations arise with determining course of action.
- Player is able to keep an active eye on others in their pairing with regard to score, pace of play and USGA rules governess
- Player has the ability to maintain pace of play with the group in front of them
- Player is able to promote good sportsmanship
- Player will practice respect and integrity toward the game, the host facility and their fellow competitors
- Players can display proper course etiquette & dress code respect the golf course, repair divots, rake bunkers, etc.
- Players are interested in a higher level of play/competition

Event Format:

- Governed by USGA Rules
- Stroke play - ball must go in the hole
- This division plays Stroke & Distance, [Stroke & Distance Rule USGA Rule 18.1 Explained](#)
- Players in this division will compete for points at each event, top players will be invited to the WNYPGA Jr Tour Championship at the end of the season. 36 hole events will carry double point values.
- Players in this division will compete for Player of the Year honors, based on event points earned
- Mobile Scoring through the Golf Genius app will serve as the official score card
