RightsCon is just around the corner. We wanted to send a little note to attendees regarding the Schengen visa.

Take a look at these tips and documentation needed to successfully obtain a Schengen visa:

- Arrange the appointment at a sufficient number of days prior to your departure. The visa process
  is time-consuming. Because of the current geopolitical climate, the embassy might need more
  time to run background checks. So apply as early as possible.
- Valid passport (at least 3 months prior to your departure is required).
- Fully completed visa application form and 1 passport-format photo. (Look at the consulate website you are applying from and find the application and other requirements there).
- Round trip reservation or itinerary with dates and flight numbers specifying entry and exit from the Schengen area.
- Schengen travel visa insurance. Insurance companies offer travel insurance for a very reasonable price. To learn more about the requirements click <a href="here">here</a>
- Proof of accommodation for the whole duration of the intended stay in the Schengen area. If you
  are willing to stay at Crowne Plaza Hotel, our conference venue, please follow this link for
  reservation.
- Proof of sufficient fund during the intended stay in the Schengen area. Varies from country to country. Consulate officers often ask for a statement of your bank account or proof of travel support.
- Any other documents that prove your ties to your home country are highly recommended. These
  include a valid employment letter, school enrollment verification letter, family ties, evidence of a
  business, car or land ownership.
- If you have ever gotten a Schengen visa, make sure to have a document to support it, such as older passport or copy of the former Schengen visa.
