Students must submit a PN program application to the Health Sciences Admissions Coordinator by February 1st for consideration of admission in the following fall semester. To be eligible for a program application, the student must meet the following criteria:

- Students must be eligible for enrollment in ENG 111 and MAT 171
- The student's overall grade point average must be 2.0 or higher
- Students must demonstrate current certification on the North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry.

A minimum grade of "C" is required for non-NUR courses, and a minimum grade of "B" is required for NUR courses
