NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VAN BUREN, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That a fee of **\$1,250.00** be charged to a property owner within the Van Buren Service Area when connecting to the Village freshwater system;

SECTION 2: That a fee of **\$2,000.00** be charged to a property owner within the Van Buren Service Area when connecting to the Village sanitary system;

SECTION 3: The Van Buren Service Area is defined as to the area bounded on the south by the north of the center line of Hancock County Road 109, on the north to the Hancock County Property Line, on the east by the westside of the centerline on Allen Township Road 232, and on the west by the eastside of the centerline of Hancock County Road 140.

SECTION 4: That no person or entity is permitted to connect to the high pressure 10" line running from the northern line of the City of Findlay to the southern line of the Village of Van Buren (Hancock County Road 220).

SECTION 5: The City of Findlay maintains and operates the water and sanitary sewer system to and within the Van Buren Service Area. Therefore, water and sanitary sewer taps are regulated/governed by City of Findlay. For information regarding water and sewer taps fees, please contact the Findlay City Engineers office.

SECTION 6: Please send the completed Water and Sanitary Sewer Application along with a check to the Village of Van Buren, Attn: Zoning Inspector, P. O. Box 275, Van Buren, OH.

SECTION 7: The Village of Van Buren requires the issuance of a zoning permit prior to the commencement of any project. Please send the completed zoning permit to the Village of Van Buren, Attn: Zoning Inspector, P. O. Box 275, Van Buren, OH 45889 along with the required [application fees](#) amount. Each zoning permit needs a separate check with the lot number printed in the check memo.
