NBLC Scholarship For 12th Grade High School Students

NBLC Academic Excellence Scholarship (\$500.00)

This scholarship is open to members who are 12th grade high school students during the year of the application. This scholarship is for those students who have achieved academic excellence during their four years in high school. Applicants to this scholarship must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher, complete an application, submit a high school transcript, and write a two-page essay on "How I Achieved Academic Excellence." One scholarship per year will be awarded to a NBLC member.

*Application Deadline: January 1, 2025

NBLC Special Achievement Scholarship (\$500.00)

This scholarship is open to members who are 12th grade high school students during the year of the application. This scholarship is for students who achieved and/or improved in spite of obstacles. Applicants to this scholarship must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, complete an application, submit a high school transcript, and write a two-page essay on "How I Achieved Academic Excellence, In Spite of Obstacles." One scholarship per year will be awarded to a NBLC member.

*Application Deadline: January 1, 2025

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be a member of an NBLC church, for at least one year.
- Applicant must be a member in good standing, at his or her church.
- Applicant must be eligible to receive a high school diploma from an accredited high school during the year of the application.
- Applicant must plan to attend a post-secondary institution (2-year college, 4-year college, trade/technical school, etc).
- Applicant must have a 3.5 or higher GPA (for Academic Excellence Scholarship only) OR 2.5 GPA (for Special Achievement Scholarship)

Application Instructions

- Applications must be typed or printed in black ink.
- The application must be submitted and be postmarked by the appropriate application deadline.
- A copy of the applicant's high school transcript (grades 9-12) should be attached.
- Applicant should write a two-page, double-spaced, typed essay on one of the assigned topics: <u>Academic Excellence Scholarship Applicants</u>: "How I Achieved Academic Excellence." <u>Special Achievement Scholarship Applicants</u>: "How I Achieved In Spite of Obstacles."
- This scholarship will be sent directly to the student's college or university. Students will be ask to provide the name & address of the college they plan to attend, when awarded the scholarship.
