Cancellation Policy 2026

As a golf chapter, we experience a very high number of cancellations for league play, most of which occur AFTER the cutoff day/time for response as identified by the League Captain in the Welcome Letter.

We want all of our members to know and understand that we, as LPGA Amateur Golf Association Eastern Shore MD/DE pay a fraction of what many other golfers pay to play at beautiful and prestigious golf courses on the Eastern Shore. We have a very good relationship with the golf pros/staff at the golf courses where we play. We want to continue this relationship and keep the excellent rates we are offered; therefore, we feel we owe the courses something in return. We need to extend to them the courtesy and time to fill empty slots with other golfers. This becomes problematic if our members cancel after the deadline indicated in the Captains Welcome Letter. Therefore all cancellations (**emergency or not**) called in after the deadline will not be invited to golf the following week. After three violations you will be removed from the league roster. We must remember that these courses count on daily revenue to maintain operations.

CANCELLATION POLICY

"If you fail to cancel by the day/time identified by your League Captain in the Welcome Letter, you will not be invited to play the following week. **In the event of a course becoming Cart Path Only, League Captains will articulate their policy in their Welcome Letter.** After three incidents, your name will be removed from that league's roster for the remainder of the season."

Please familiarize yourselves with the policies specific to the leagues in which you play, as they vary from course to course.
