Kids at Grace

By the entrance into the sanctuary, busy bags are available for children to use. During the 10:15 service, before the sermon, Ms. Coli will take children (3 and older) to the other building for an engaging lesson about our hope in Jesus. Children are returned to their families right after the prayers. There is also a quiet room outside the sanctuary with toys and the live stream, if families need a place for younger children throughout the service.

Holy Communion

This meal is weird and wonderful: weird because we actually believe that the bread and wine are the Body and Blood of Jesus the Christ; wonderful because Jesus is with us. We take this meal very seriously here at Grace. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out and allow us to answer your questions. **Children** who have not been instructed in the meaning of the Sacrament may come to the Lord's Table with their parents for a blessing but are asked to fold their arms across their chests to indicate they are to receive a blessing.

THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE COMMUNION: After the closing hymn, Pastor will pronounce the sending and then for those who wish to share in the celebration of communion shall remain. ***For those who have an intolerance to wine, grape juice is lighter colored on the tray, center.*** Those who find it difficult to walk to the altar can be communed at your seat. Please inform the usher of your need. After the Pastor has given your group the blessing at the altar, you may place your cup in the basket and depart from the Sanctuary down the center aisle, and enjoy fellowship in the hall.

Questions for the Week: The Kingdom Way - The Sermon on the Mount

1. What does the phrase "Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will Be Done" mean to you personally? How can we invite God's kingdom into our daily lives?
 2. Read Matthew 5:1-12. The sermon on the mount emphasized the Beatitudes as blessings for the "poor in spirit," the grieving, and the meek. How does this understanding of the kingdom challenge traditional ideas of power and success?
 3. The sermon contrasted different approaches to bringing about God's kingdom (Pharisees, Sadducees, Rome). In your own life, what are some "modern-day" equivalents of these approaches where we try to cover up our insufficiencies to make ourselves look more powerful? Why ultimately is there no hope in this approach?
 4. Jesus calls us to be salt and light, bringing His kingdom to others. Who in our lives might be like the "little children"-- those feeling scared or lost? How can we bring God's love and balance to them this week?

Cris's weekly input: Sermon Summary: Main Idea, Key Points, and Questions:

Summary (after Mark's Tuesday input):

This sermon explores the Sermon on the Mount and its focus on God's kingdom. It emphasizes the balanced structure of the sermon on the mount, centered on the Lord's Prayer and the plea "Thy Kingdom Come." It contrasts flawed attempts to establish God's kingdom (Pharisees, Sadducees, Roman rule) with Jesus's message that the kingdom is for the vulnerable and childlike ("poor in spirit," grieving, meek). The Beatitudes are presented as blessings for these individuals. The kingdom comes through Christ's sacrifice, not through strength or outward appearances. The speech concludes with a call to share this kingdom of peace and balance with others, especially the vulnerable.
