

CADA LEADERSHIP CAMP

TALENT SHOW PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

The CADA Leadership Camp Talent Show should be a model for other schools to follow. What we put on the CADA Camp stage should be appropriate for ages 8 to 80. Therefore, the standards we set for performances should be standards that nearly all schools can agree on in terms of song, dance, and dress code appropriateness. Your school may have standards that are stricter or more relaxed, but at CADA Camp we have chosen these guidelines so we can serve as a model for all our member schools.

General Performance Guidelines

1. All behavior, dance moves, gestures, and language should be that which would be acceptable in a typical classroom.
2. This is meant to be an all-student talent show. Advisors who wish to participate may do so in the all-Advisor Act, which will be placed as the last act in the Talent Show.
3. All acts must be auditioned prior to being allowed in the show. However, because of time constraints, the entire act may not be seen in the audition. Nevertheless, the entire performance must conform to these guidelines.

Song Choice

1. In general, songs should contain content and lyrics that would be acceptable in a typical classroom.
2. Songs should not contain sexual content or sexual innuendo (examples: Get Low, Baby Got Back, Blow My Whistle, No Hands, Drop It Like It's Hot)
3. Songs should not contain drug or alcohol references (examples: Broccoli, America's Most Blunted, Raise Your Glass, Faded)

Dress Code

1. All performers must be dressed modestly, in accordance with typical classroom dress code at school. If the authenticity of a performance requires something other than classroom attire (Polynesian costume, dance leotard, etc), costume should be approved at the time of audition.
2. No clothing shall be removed during the performance.

Performance Length

1. Please be aware that your performance length may be shortened due to the number of participants accepted into the show. You will be made aware of this after the cast list is announced.

I agree to follow the rules listed above and to present our Talent Show act in good taste. I understand if my act does not follow these guidelines, or if the act, song, gestures, or costumes presented on stage deviate from the auditioned act, your act may be subject to immediate removal from the show, and your school may be penalized by being barred from the Talent Show the following summer.
