In 2010, the Pew Research Center questioned 1308 adults in the U.S. to estimate the proportion of the population favoring marijuana use for medical purposes. It was found that 73% are in favor of using marijuana for medical purposes. State the population, sample, parameter and statistic.

Answer:

Statistic: 73% of the respondents that are in favor of using marijuana for medical purposes.

Population: US Adults

Sample: 1308 adults in the US

Parameter: Percent of US adults who support using marijuana for medical purposes.

Question

Determine whether the value is a parameter or statistic. Medical researchers measured the heights of 125 males and found their mean height to 69.5 inches.

Answer

The value is a statistic.

Question

Suppose you want to know what high school incoming freshman at a particular college came from. To estimate the percentage of incoming freshman from each of the area's high schools you take a sample of 200 incoming college freshman. State the population, sample, parameter and statistic.

Answer

Population: Incoming Freshman at this college.

Sample: 200 incoming Freshman sampled.

Parameter: Percent of incoming Freshmen from each of the area's high schools.

Statistic: Percent of the 200 incoming Freshmen who graduated from each area high school.

Question

Because of the difficulty of weighing a bear in the woods, researchers caught and measured 54 bears, recording their weight, neck size, length, and sex. They hoped to find a way to estimate weight from the other, more easily determined quantities. Name the quantitative variables in the study.

Answer

weight, neck size, length

Question

A political action committee is interested in the proportion of all registered voters who will vote "Yes" on a measure to expand the use of solar energy. Match the vocabulary word with its corresponding example. 791 voters were selected and the 53% said that they would vote "Yes" on the measure to expand the use of solar energy. State the population, sample, parameter and statistic.

Answer

Population: All registered voters

Sample: 791 voters

Parameter: Proportion of all registered voters that will support the measure to expand the use of solar energy.

Statistic: 53% of the sample that said they would support the measure to expand the use of solar energy.

Question

Determine whether the sampling method described below appears to be sound or flawed: In a survey of 753 subjects, each was asked how often he or she watched TV. The survey subjects were internet users who responded to a question that was posted on a news website.

Answer

It is flawed because it is a voluntary response survey.

Question

Because of the difficulty of weighing a bear in the woods, researchers caught and measured 54 bears, recording their weight, neck size, length, and sex. They hoped to find a way to estimate weight from the other, more easily determined quantities. What are the observational units in this study?

Answer

The observational units are the 54 bears.

Question

A doctor wants to know if treatment A or treatment B works faster on removing a wart. He randomly selects which treatment to use on a sample of patients needing warts removed. Is this an observational study or an experiment? Why?

Answer

It is an experiment because the treatments were randomly assigned to the patients.

Answer

This is a cluster sample.
