Angel - (MSU) Liver chestnut pony mare. **Height Weight #135 5' 5"** Super easy ride, set up for leads and keep leg on at lope. No spurs, goes one handed.

Cinnamon - (MSU) Chestnut mare. KICKS, keep by herself. Easy ride, goes one handed, can have ball spurs. Keep leg on. Crop Option. Ball Spur Only **Height Weight #150 5' 9"**

Diamond - (MSU) Appaloosa mare. Super easy ride, no spurs. Can get antsy in patterns, needs to be kept quiet. Use Voice commands and hum to slow and calm. One or two handed, would recommend two for patterns.

Hollywood - (MSU) Bay gelding. Short/Small Ball spurs. Rowel option for reining only. If spurs used too aggressively, he will buck and resist. One or two handed on the rail, recommend two if reining or patterns. Needs to be kept together in his pivots, simple lead changes.

Bo (MSU) - Buckskin Gelding, Reiner, Can he "hot" to start pattern, allow to jog into pen, Ball or Rowel Spur, 1 or 2 hand option, ease into stops. Allow pause between maneuvers and spins. Set up for maneuvers, give rein in spins, he likes to stretch neck in spins. Don't Trap.

Royal Creek Horses

Harlee (Royal Creek) Ranch type. NO SPURS. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead change, and quiet in circles. He is best "slow handed" in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.

Jett Royal (Royal Creek) BAY GELDING QH. RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS –VERY EASY TO RIDE

Laredo (Royal Creek) PAINT GELDING. SWEET HORSE -RETIRED SHOW HORSE - BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE

SOUTHERN OHIO

Allie (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH, Light Contact, cluck for jog, kiss for lope, setup for leads. 2 hands for patterns, neck rein for rail. Spurs according to division.

Annie (Southern Ohio) Chestnut QH mare. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Use voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or release stop. Spurs can be used according to division, but not recommended for Emerald/beginner riders.

Cecil (Southern Ohio) Very smooth, easy ride. Spur OK, will walk & trot fine with no spur. He will do a flying lead change if you do not keep your body correct.

Coco(Southern Ohio) Bay QH Gelding. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used according to division, but not recommended for Emerald/beginner riders.

ECHO (Southern Ohio) Dark Bay QH. Consistent, but light rein contact. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs according to division. One or two hand option. Two hands for patterns.

George (Southern Ohio) Bay Roan QH. Consistent, but light rein contact. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs not needed, but allowed for Sapphire and Diamond riders.

Jett Southern (Southern Ohio) Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, he will need a crop. Cluck & kick for jog; Kiss & cue for lope. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs/spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected.

Nelson (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Needs light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. Use spurs according to division and if non allowed, you'll need to cluck and kick aggressively or carry a crop. Can be lazy. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow.

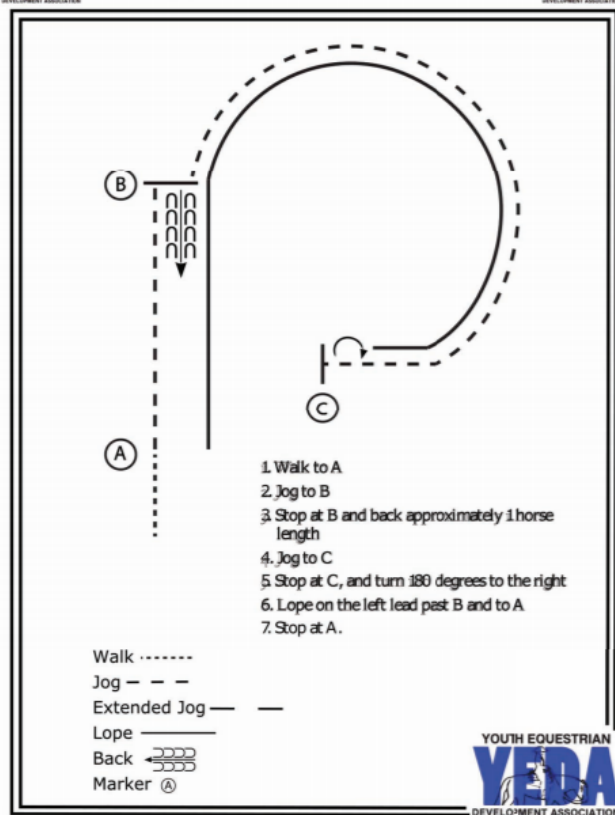
River (Southern Ohio) **Weight #150** Grey gelding. Very soft, no spurs keep tight rein. Use more voice than leg. Click for jog, kiss for lope.

Rolf (Southern Ohio) Fjord. Can use spur, more spur used the slower he will go with a tight rein. Can use crop if needed for walk trot.

Ruby (Southern Ohio) Appaloosa Mare (red roan look). Use consistent, but light contact. She will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on her face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs allowed according to division.

Stu (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Very solid draw. Needs light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. Use spurs according to division and if non allowed, you'll need to cluck and kick aggressively or carry a crop. Takes leads easily and has a flying lead change. Can be lazy. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow.

Smarty (Southern Ohio) **Height Weight 5'9" #150** Sorrel QH gelding with a ranchy look. Maintain consistent rein contact. Keep legs light/off. Very light cues. Just wave legs and cluck for jog, as he may lope off with a kick. Will respond to voice commands. Cluck for jog, kiss for lope. Whoa/Walk. Check back and release to slow jog or lope. Set up for leads. NO spurs.

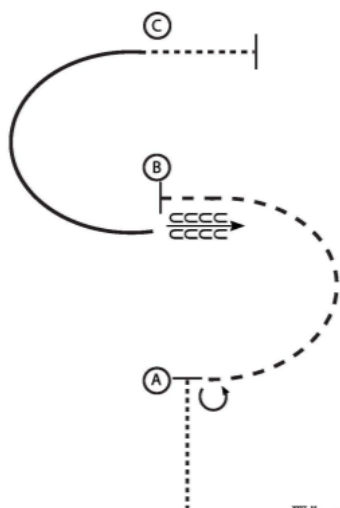

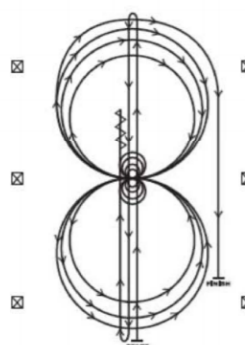

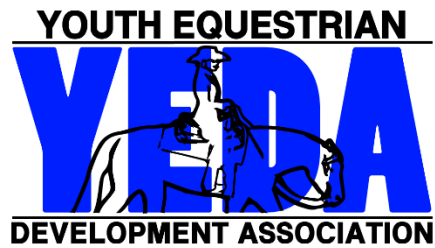

5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Angel - (MSU) Liver chestnut pony mare. **Height Weight #135 5' 5"** Super easy ride, set up for leads and keep leg on at lope. No spurs, goes one handed.

Cinnamon - (MSU) Chestnut mare. KICKS, keep by herself. Easy ride, goes one handed, can have ball spurs. Keep leg on. Crop Option. Ball Spur Only **Height Weight #150 5' 9"**

Diamond - (MSU) Appaloosa mare. Super easy ride, no spurs. Can get antsy in patterns, needs to be kept quiet. Use Voice commands and hum to slow and calm. One or two handed, would recommend two for patterns.

Hollywood - (MSU) Bay gelding. Short/Small Ball spurs. Rowel option for reining only. If spurs used too aggressively, he will buck and resist. One or two handed on the rail, recommend two if reining or patterns. Needs to be kept together in his pivots, simple lead changes.

Bo (MSU) - Buckskin Gelding, Reiner, Can he "hot" to start pattern, allow to jog into pen, Ball or Rowel Spur, 1 or 2 hand option, ease into stops. Allow pause between maneuvers and spins. Set up for maneuvers, give rein in spins, he likes to stretch neck in spins. Don't Trap.

Royal Creek Horses

Harlee (Royal Creek) Ranch type. Division Appropriate Spurs. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead change, and quiet in circles. He is best "slow handed" in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.

Jett Royal (Royal Creek) BAY GELDING QH. RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS –VERY EASY TO RIDE. Crop Option

SOUTHERN OHIO

Allie (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH, Light Contact, cluck for jog, kiss for lope, setup for leads. 2 hands for patterns, neck rein for rail. Spurs according to division.

Annie (Southern Ohio) Chestnut QH mare. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Use voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or release stop. Spurs can be used according to division, but not recommended for Emerald/beginner riders.

Cecil (Southern Ohio) Very smooth, easy ride. Spur OK, will walk & trot fine with no spur. He will do a flying lead change if you do not keep your body correct.

Coco(Southern Ohio) Bay QH Gelding. Use quiet hands & consistent, but light contact. He will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on his face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & wave legs for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Responds best to easy/light legs/cues. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs can be used according to division, but not recommended for Emerald/beginner riders.

ECHO (Southern Ohio) Dark Bay QH. Consistent, but light rein contact. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs according to division. One or two hand option. Two hands for patterns.

George (Southern Ohio) Bay Roan QH. Consistent, but light rein contact. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs not needed, but allowed for Sapphire and Diamond riders.

Jett Southern (Southern Ohio) Black QH gelding. Light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. If contact is too tight, he won't move forward. Use spurs according to division and if none are allowed, he will need a crop. Cluck & kick for jog; Kiss & cue for lope. Can be very lazy but does very well with a confident rider not afraid to use legs/spurs. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow/uncollected.

Nelson (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Needs light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. Use spurs according to division and if non allowed, you'll need to cluck and kick aggressively or carry a crop. Can be lazy. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow.

River (Southern Ohio) **Weight #150** Grey gelding. Very soft, no spurs keep tight rein. Use more voice than leg. Click for jog, kiss for lope.

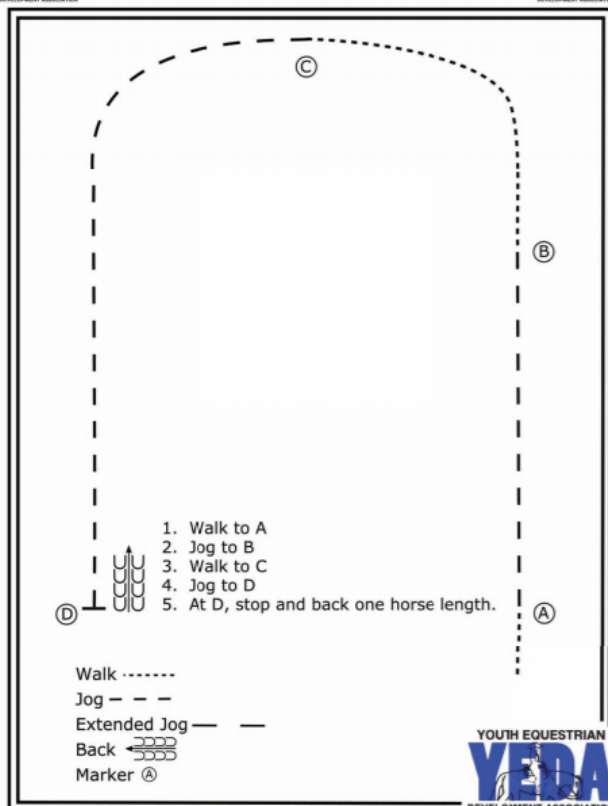
Rolf (Southern Ohio) Fjord. Can use spur, more spur used the slower he will go with a tight rein. Can use crop if needed for walk trot.

Ruby (Southern Ohio) Appaloosa Mare (red roan look). Use consistent, but light contact. She will get cranky if reins are too short or if you pull on her face. Responds to voice commands. Cluck & kick lightly for jog and kiss/cue for lope. Whoa/Walk. Will respond to spur stop or neck rein. Spurs allowed according to division.

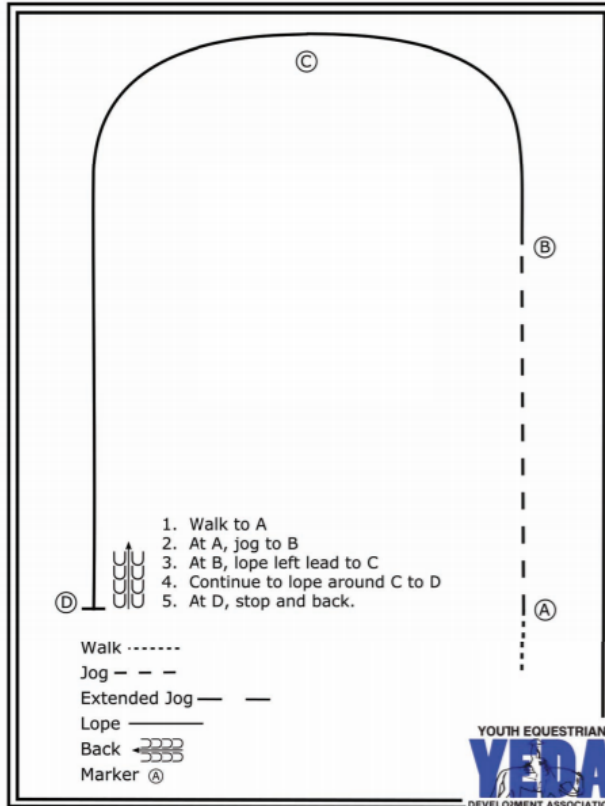
Stu (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Very solid draw. Needs light rein contact and lots of leg/spur. Use spurs according to division and if non allowed, you'll need to cluck and kick aggressively or carry a crop. Takes leads easily and has a flying lead change. Can be lazy. Continue kissing and consistent leg contact through lope if he gets too slow.

Smarty (Southern Ohio) **Height Weight 5'9" #150** Sorrel QH gelding with a ranchy look. Maintain consistent rein contact. Keep legs light/off. Very light cues. Just wave legs and cluck for jog, as he may lope off with a kick. Will respond to voice commands. Cluck for jog, kiss for lope. Whoa/Walk. Check back and release to slow jog or lope. Set up for leads. NO spurs.

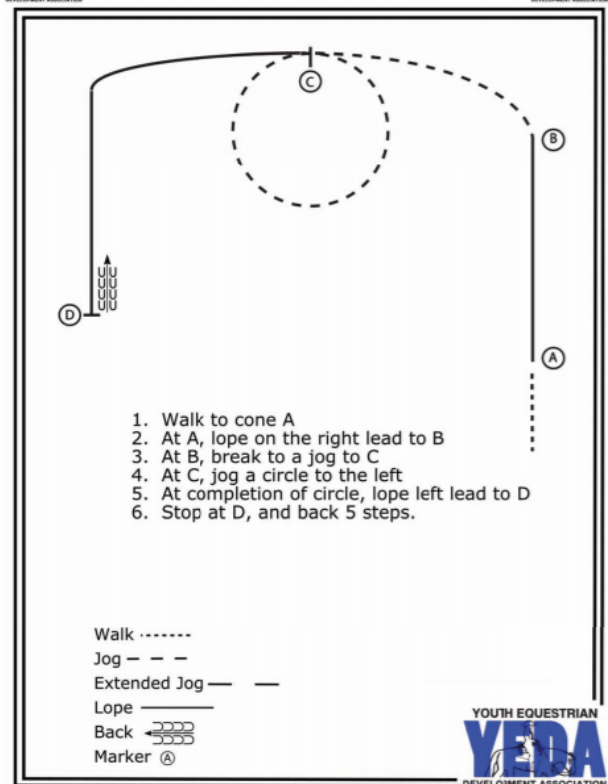
Opal/Pearl Pattern 2



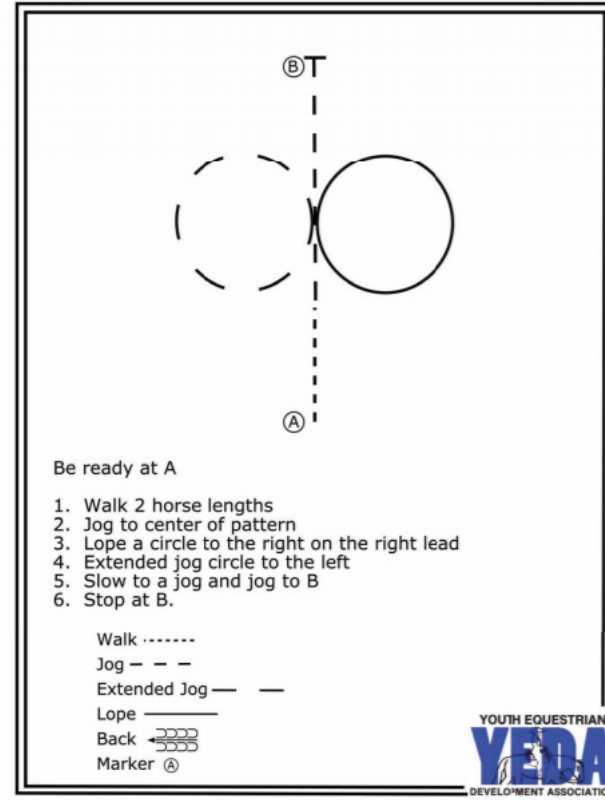
Emerald Pattern 2



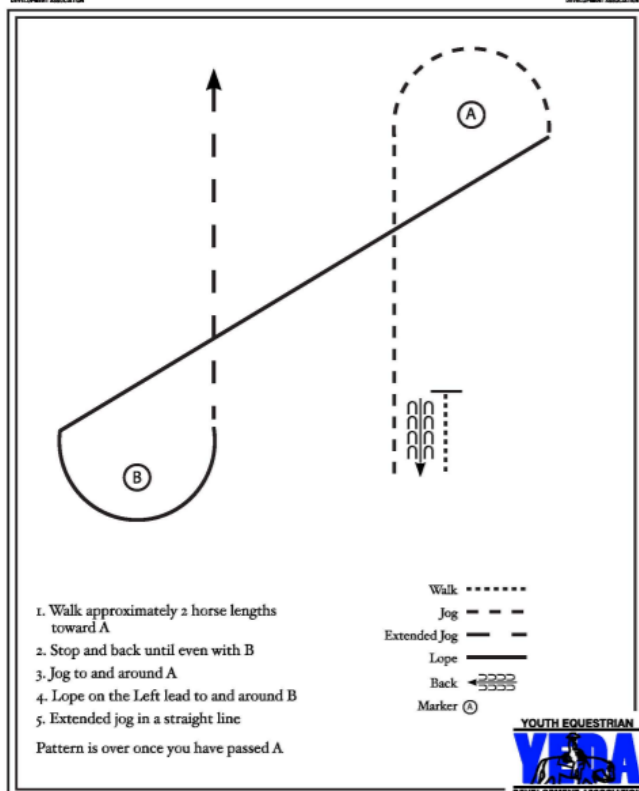
Ruby Pattern 2



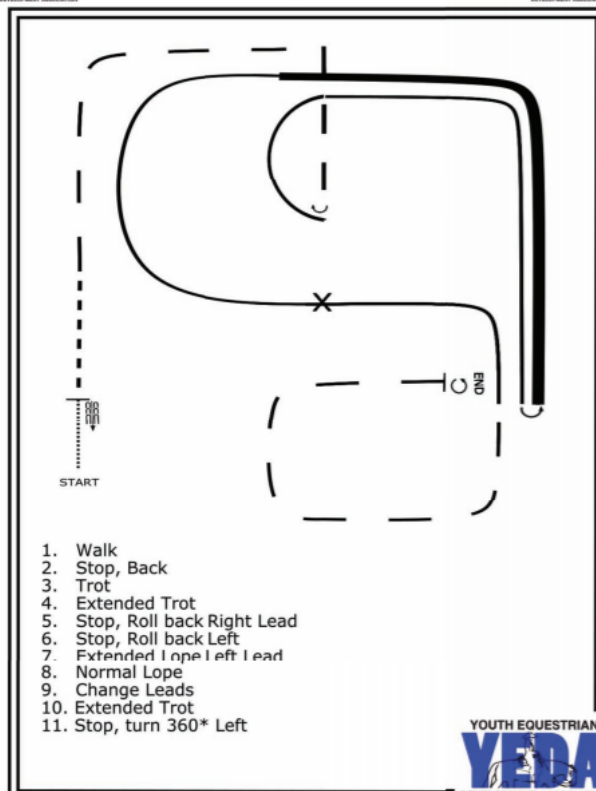
Sapphire/Alumni Pattern 2



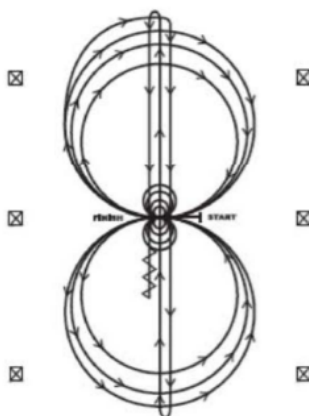
Diamond Pattern 2

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.
- Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.
