of Formal Relations Between the Würtige Empire and the Republic of Tinland

Title I: The Parties

- 1. The Würtige Empire and the Republic of Tinland hereafter, in this treaty, are as the 'Signatories';
- 2. In Acknowledging their sovereign rights and territorial integrity;
- 3. And Expressing a desire to further develop and promote bilateral relations with the other:
- 4. Do set forth the following in the interests of mutual cooperation.

Title II: Mutual Cooperation

- 5. The Signatories;
 - a. Agree not to violate the independence of, or infringe upon the sovereignty of, the other;
 - b. And agree to commit to non-aggression by committing to resolving any dispute between them cordially;
 - c. By granting the right to house a diplomatic mission within each other's territories to maintain and further diplomatic relations between each other.

Title III: The Community

- 6. The Signatories agree to further preserve peace in the community by working together in advancing the rights of all;
- 7. And working for the greater good of their joint communities and the communities they exist within.

Title IV: Recognition of Rights

- 8. The Signatories will recognise the right to citizenship of each other's citizens and grant;
 - a. The right to dual citizenship for those who seek it, or are entitled to it by domestic law.

Title V: Commencement, Withdrawal and Amendment

- 9. This treaty will commence upon the ratification within the Signatories' domestic processes, and after it has been signed by each nations legal representatives.
- 10. Each Signatory may withdraw from this treaty after giving the other a 48 hour warning of withdrawal, after which the terms of the treaty will terminate.
- 11. The Signatories may jointly Amend this treaty as required.
