## **Our History**




On Saturday, October 4, 1912, a group of migrant Christians gathered to organize the first Black Missionary Baptist church in what was then

known as Fuquay Springs. This meeting was held in the Masonic Hall near the site of the present structure.

Reverend Paul Yancey was the spiritual advisor for this historic venture and became the first pastor. There were 15 members when the church was organized, and today First Baptist Church is a living monument to their labor.
