Target Audience

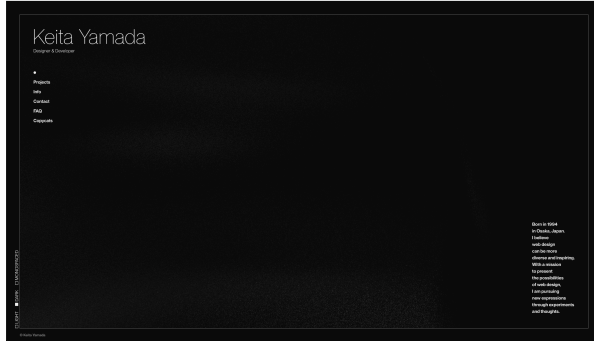

 - **Works/Projects Page or Section** (e.g. with thumbs for each project)
 - Different types:

 - Stacked sections

- **Portfolio Entry/Case Studies**
- **Custom about page**
 - With a short intro (ie mission statement)
 - Links to resume, linkedin, how to contact (form) etc
- **Specific Portfolio Project Design Patterns**
