7. Business climate has improved due to Maunakea Market Place Food court bringing in more tourists and locals to buy lunch and take out.
8. HPD has been helpful to remove illegal vendors and illegal parking at Kekaulike and Nimitz.
9. Chinese New Year of the Fire Horse is 2 weeks away n folks are buying stuff to decorate their homes and offices – Chinatown is busier.
