## Frequently Asked Questions

### *What is the program about?*

Operating before the start of semester and during orientation week, this orientation program is designed to enhance student well-being and increase community engagement. Student volunteers work with peers to show them the social side of university life. Additionally, for the student volunteers, Host Scheme provides leadership and training opportunities for students of all ages. By becoming a part of the Host Scheme team, you are joining a program where you can develop your ability to lead.

### *What does the program involve?*

There are four key components to the program. These are: volunteer training, events, Host Scheme camps and Orientation Week.

**Training:** Student volunteers are trained to be approachable leaders within the Monash community. They are shown key services that the MSA and the university has to offer and are highly knowledgeable about the number of social events run on or off campus. They understand the experience of new students. They are also trained to deliver campus tours to both small and large groups of students and non-students.

**Events:** Host Scheme runs a number of events across the orientation period to assist students with their social transition to university life. There is a diverse range of events that is offered from day events on campus to night events off campus. In the past, Host Scheme has run the following events: movies nights on the Northern Plaza of campus, bowling at Melbourne Central, Eureka Skydeck tours, Melbourne Gaol ghost tours and parties at the Colonial Hotel.

**Camps:** Our three day camps are held at the beautiful Lord Somers campsite. We meet at the Clayton campus and all head to the campsite together on the hired coaches. From there, the camp leaders and volunteers facilitate a number of activities and workshops, from juggling to Quidditch. All volunteer attendance at the camp is subsidised by the Monash Student Association.

**Orientation Week:** Host Scheme operates a number of key orientation services during this week. These range from running campus tours, serving free food and operating hair braiding stations.

### *When does the program operate?*

Host Scheme primarily operates in the weeks leading up to the semester and then the first few weeks of semester. Volunteer only events will also be run during the semester.

### *What are the benefits of participating?*

There are a number of reasons to participate in the Host Scheme program. By becoming a Host Scheme volunteer you are:

- Increasing your social support network
- Developing your leadership skills
- Developing your communication skills
- Giving back to the Monash community
- Establishing a flexible work skill set
- Eligible to redeem MSA volunteer points for MSA vouchers

MSA volunteer points can be redeemed at any MSA related business (Sir John's Bar, Wholefoods, MUST and MTPD).

Volunteer points: one point per hour for Host Scheme (unless otherwise stated by the Volunteer Coordinator). This might take the form of conducting campus tours, staffing an MSA Volunteering booth or speaking at student panels.

*How do I join the program?*

You join the program by signing up as an MSA volunteer and then specifically, an Host Scheme volunteer. It is strongly recommended that you have attended at least one semester of university prior to commencing in the program as this allows you to be more informed about the university experience and the services available.

You must also hold a Working With Children Check. This is essential because of the diverse nature of the Monash community. Not all individuals that you interact with will be over the age of 18.
