Sharing is an important way to introduce children to preparing and presenting an oral presentation, so please help your child prepare for their sharing day. Sharing dates and topics are below:

The sharing topics will be:

Week of April 29th--Toy Share: On the toy share week, children must bring a toy hidden in a bag. They also must have three clues written about the toy. The objective is that after the "sharer" reads the three clues, the rest of the class will be able to guess what is inside the bag. This makes it fun for everyone. Please help your child think of good clues so that we can make a guess about what's in the bag. It is important to be prepared to keep the momentum up so that all the children remain interested. On the toy share week, I do not want toy weapons of any kind or toys of a violent/warlike nature being brought in.

Week of May 6th-- Book Share: Each child will share a favorite book. I would like children to be prepared to tell the title, what the book is about, why they like the book, and show a favorite page.

Week of May 13th-- Poetry/Song/Nursery Rhyme Share: Learning songs and poems is very important to pre-reading skills. Your child can pick a favorite song, poem, or nursery rhyme to say/sing for the class. If your child knows a poem or song in another language, I highly encourage him/her to share that with us!!

Week of May 20th-- Homemade Share: This item should be something your child has made, either at home or in an art class or child care, etc. They may share pictures, crafts, et cetera, and we would like them to be prepared to talk about how they made the item.

Week of May 29th-- Toy Share. We will end with where we began, Toy Share (same as week of 4/29). **Children who share on Monday (Memorial Day) may share any other day that week.**
