# **Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR)**

#### What is it?

Electronic form where students can self-report courses and grades that have been completed or will be completed in high school for WHS credit.

Schools may require the SRAR be submitted with the application or provide a separate deadline. Check school specific websites for information.

#### TIPS FOR COMPLETING YOUR SRAR FOR WHS STUDENTS:

- Use the same email address as you used for your Common App. These must match so your SRAR can be linked with your applications!
- WHS CEEB Code = 222440
- WHS only reports final letter grades so enter your courses as "Full Year" and and for your semester courses adjust the credits to 2.5
- Use the WHS Transcript that you received at your fall workshop to complete your SRAR
- WHS does not calculate or report an unweighted GPA
- Winchester only has three course levels: College Prep, Honors and AP
- All classes that appear on your transcript should be reported on your SRAR (including P.E., Student Assistant Semester, and OL courses). Directed Study does not appear on your transcript and thus should not be reported on the SRAR
