

## Important Information:

**LATE ARRIVALS TO SCHOOL:** Students arriving to school after 7:50 am, for any reason, need to sign in at the office and obtain a pass to class.

**CHECKING YOUR STUDENT OUT EARLY:** Students may only be checked out early by an adult whose name is listed on the student's contact tab in Alma. **An identification card must be shown since we will not know every adult listed in Alma as a contact or an emergency contact.** Please allow enough time to follow this procedure as it will not be waived because people are in a hurry.

**ABSENCES:** If your child is absent, please call the school at 916-933-9290, extension 4 or by using the on-line [absence form](#) (Bookmark this link), first thing in the morning. **Please know that students are considered to be chronic absentees if they are absent more than 10% of the school year to date, whether absences are excused or unexcused.**

**INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACTS:** The state of California requires that Independent Study Contracts may only be set up for students who will be out of school for three (3) or more CONSECUTIVE days not to exceed 15 days per year. Please note you must give the school a minimum notice of five (5) school days to take out a contract! We thank you for planning ahead. **Please be aware that contracts cannot be taken out due to illness, and interdistrict students do not qualify for contracts.**
