Student Learning Expectations

During our remote learning days, our students will:

- Attend your scheduled therapy session
- Be respectful
- Try your best
- Use “Whole Body Listening”
- Create a space and dedicated time for learning
- Sit straight up with your feet flat on the floor in front of the camera
- Have all needed materials ready to use
- Finish your meals or snacks prior to logging on
- Take movement breaks
- Seek help when needed (therapists, teachers)
- Sign into the classrooms daily- keep connected
- Use Google Calendar to organize classes
- Engage with the classroom and use tools (like headphones) to focus on instructional videos, etc.
- Reach out to your therapy provider if you are overwhelmed
- Collaborate with peers using respectful language and behaviors
- Use equipment as outlined in the Acceptable Use Policy.
