- killed more than 8,000 people and injured more than 18,000
- Hundreds of thousands of people were made homeless.
- Some entire towns were flattened.
- Was near Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal.
- Countries all over the world donating money to support Nepal.

- Today Wednesday Morning a second big magnitude-7.3 quake hit nepal.
- The earthquake triggered an avalanche on Mount Everest, killing at least 19 people.
- Baby saved after being trapped for 22 hours.
- UNICEF is helping children.
- About 100 New Zealanders are in Nepal.
- About 1 million children can not go to school because about 24,000 classrooms have been damaged.
