Choose from the ideas below how you would like to share your learning, about the Pope, from the previous tasks.

Prepare a Presentation

Prepare a presentation to share about the role and responsibility of the bishop as a leader of the church in your Diocese. Include his relationship with the Pope. Then share this with your family, whānau, face to face or on Skype.

Create an Artwork

Create An artwork to illustrate the relationship between the Pope, the bishops and the People of God. Mount an exhibition of all the artworks in a place where they can be admired and shared.

Make a Postcard

Write a postcard and address it to a friend. Imagine by some extraordinary circumstance you find yourself in a deserted place. A friend is just beginning to get to know the teaching of Jesus. Write on the postcard the most important things about Jesus that you would like him or her to know. Share what you write and justify your choices. Display your postcard on a mobile for others to read and talk about .
