- Keep a consistent light source and render the composition with **FULL range of values** using your drawing pencil set

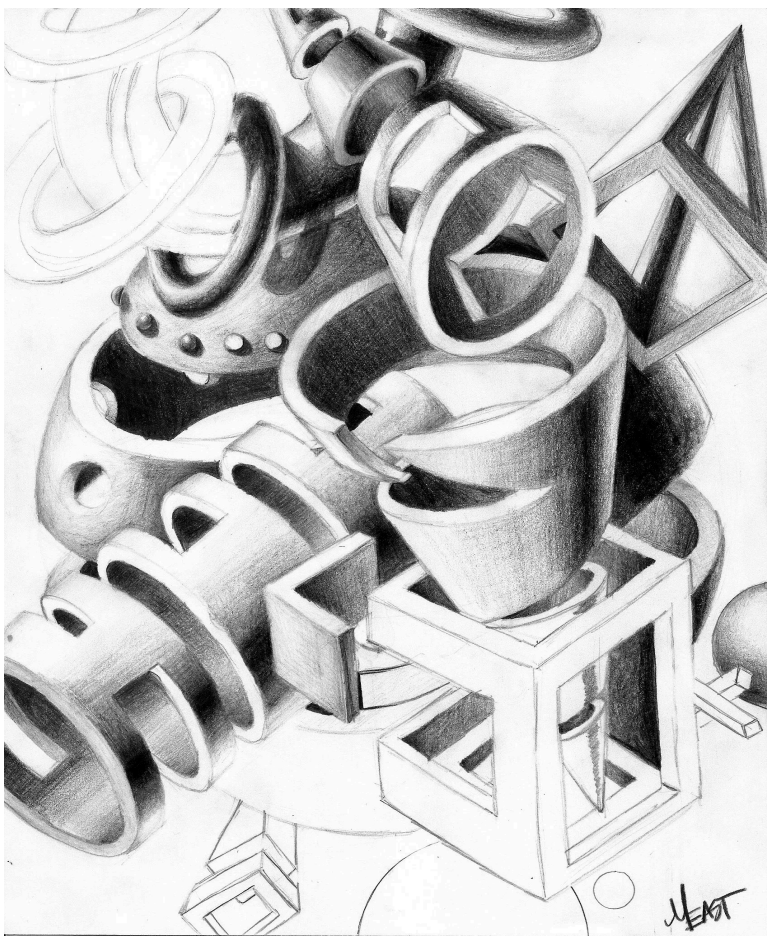
