I had the Armor.bin error for 2 days and I fixed it on my computer after a lot of editing. I'll type all the steps I did the last time that made it work for me!

READ FIRST: IF YOU GET ERRORS THAT ARE MENTIONED IN THE !KNOWN IN DISCORD PLEASE DO THOSE STEPS ALSO. IF THEY ARE NOT LISTED THERE JUST RESTART PC AND CONTINUE.

- 1. Checked my graphic drivers and updated them.
- 2. Uninstall Diablo II and Diablo II LOD + PD2" Launcher (Make sure you go into regedit and remove diablo 2 from there as well + windows button and search "remove" to get into "add and remove programs). Search for diablo 2 and uninstall. Search for PD2 and uninstall.
- 3. Check ur Virus protection, firewall and network protection and app & browser control.
 - Click on Virus & threat protection manage settings disable all
 - Click on Firewall & network protection turn off domain network turn off private network turn off public network.
 - Click on App & browser control Turn it off.
- 4. Now make sure there is no Diablo II or PD2 launcher or old rar files, remove everything you downloaded and do fresh download from https://www.blizzard.com/en-us/
- 5. I downloaded the EU version since I'm in EU but I think US works fine too.
- 6. Download both and install them where the installation requests. Mine was "C:\Program Files (x86)\Diablo II\"
- 7. Download PD2 launcher at https://www.projectdiablo2.com/Download
- 8. Install PD2 Launcher, make sure to set as admin if it isn't and launch it. If it works you can quit here if not try this under.
- 9. Find your "Diablo II" folder and locate Diablo II.exe and Game.exe https://prnt.sc/vcslvi
- 10. Change Compatibility mode to Windows 7 and Admin for both and start Diablo II.exe until you get to the login screen and do the same with Game.exe. Don't panic if it updates diablo.
- 11. Now remove Compatibility from Diablo II.exe and Game.exe
- 12. Start PD2 Launcher again and try, if this still dont work restart your computer and try again.
- 13. If it still doesn't work after restart go to "downloads" and start the "ProjectD2Installer" and uninstall and install it after.
- 14. Make sure PD2 Launcher is Admin and try to run it (maybe try a restart if it doesn't work)
- 15. IF you still have issues you can try to go back to "Downloads" and find "ProjectD2Installer" and click it, repair, and restart + launch again.

If this worked you can turn back the antivirus and firewall:)

This is what I did and it worked. Let me know if it works for you!
