Coordinating Conjunctions

- 1) Define -
 - A word used to connect other words or groups of words.
- 2) Example FAN BOYS
 - I want to shop, and he wants to eat.
- **3) Tips:**
 - "Glues" words and/or sentences together
 - When joining sentences, you must use a comma before the conjunction!!!

Correlative Conjunctions

- 1) Define -
 - A pair of words used to connect other words or groups of words.
- 2) Example -
 - Neither will she go nor participate in the activity.
- 3) **Tips:**
 - If you find one, look for another!!!

Subordinating Conjunctions

- 1) Define -
 - Connects two ideas by making one of them less important than the other
- 2) Example A WHITE BUS
 - <u>If</u> I go with you, will you drive?
- **3) Tips:**
 - Watch comma placement with subordinating conjunctions!!! (middle or none)

Conjunctive Adverbs

- 1) Define -
 - An adverb that acts as a conjunction to connect complete ideas.
- 2) Example -
 - He is smart; although, he gets bad grades.
- 3) **Tips:**
 - ; before the word
 - , after the word
