The Sultan said a long time ago that the Sultanate does not follow anyone except the teaching of the Religion of Islam, in response the Ummah Act was created declaring that the nation will serve Islam and the Muslims and declaring Israel as an enemy to the state. This document is adding to the Ummah Act. This new law is one of the most controversial laws and may cause Qardasha to lose a lot of allies/support/citizens.

Regarding the hijab, when asked, it was stated that only Muslims had to wear it and that everyone else had freedom of religion. The law regarding freedom of religion will be protected and enforced but from 13 January 2022; Jummadal-Awwal II 9, 1443 A.H, **all women are required to wear hijab**. Hijab will be *enforced* not forced.

Women are required to wear hijab, not a burqa or niqab.
This means that you are allowed to wear hijab very loosely although it is not recommended and you should still wear modest clothing.
