Learning in the Digital Age

Supporting the growth of online learning, Orange Unified offers online “virtual” classes using 21st Century tools. **OrangeLIVE!** (Learning through Interactive Virtual Education) classes provide students with opportunities to experience an online learning environment, gain graduation credits, and enroll in courses that might be otherwise unavailable at their schools. Students will complete technology-rich assignments including projects, surveys, digital videos, interactive textbook tasks, web-based reading assignments, problem-solving, analysis, and “virtual chats.”

OrangeLive! Classes

- Taught by Orange Unified credentialed, highly-qualified teachers
- Teachers maintain a password-protected virtual classroom through the district Learning Management System with postings of the course syllabus, regular assignments, and class grades
- Paced by the teacher on a weekly basis
- Follow the same board-adopted curriculum and textbooks as the traditional courses





- Meet California state standards
- Teachers and students interact frequently via email, virtual class Collaborate sessions, voice boards, blogs, wikis, Remind, and online discussions through the virtual classroom
- Tests and exams are offered in a proctored face-to-face environment on your high school campus
- Teachers offer online and on-site office hours
- Classes are offered at no additional cost to students
