Team Size: 30-35 Students

Rehearsal commitment:

October – November: 1 day per week

December 1st – 19th: 2-3 days per week

December 20th – January 4th (Winter Break): Rehearsals TBA for those in town

January 5th – 14th: Final Rehearsals, 2-3 weekdays + weekend

January 15th – 19th: Junior Theater Festival & Travel - Atlanta, Georgia

Team Dues Cost: \$850.00 + Travel, Hotels, Food

Eligibility & Criteria to Attend JTF:

- Commitment – the schedule both prior to the Festival and at the Festival requires an unwavering commitment; **two rehearsal absences** are permitted for each student. Students may be removed from the team if absences are unexcused and/or persistent.
- RESPECT for fellow performers, directors, production team, property and the rehearsal process
- Hard working, Dedicated, Team player, Reliable, and Punctual. Picks up choreography quickly. Listens to and can follow directions
- A good citizen able to represent Melody Lane Performing Arts Center and Cape Coral/Southwest Florida during both the process and festival trip
- The ability to be professional, kind and respectful in but not limited to all airports, on airplanes, in the hotel, at the festival, during workshops, rehearsals, backstage, performances, in their hotel room, with adults and to assigned chaperone
- All previous production involvement including school year and summer productions are also in consideration and part of each student's audition.

Junior Theater Festival Contract (Turn in on Audition Day)

Every member of the JTF Teams needs to read through this contract thoroughly and decide whether one can commit to the privilege and responsibility of being on our traveling theatre team. Such an endeavor takes time, dedication, and decorum. We are very happy to invite you to audition for our team and want all of our students to have a professional and enjoyable experience.

Adults, Please initial next to each:

___ I understand that my student is required to attend all rehearsals and performances, and that more than 2 unexcused absences may result in my removal from the team.

___ I understand that if absent for certain rehearsals, my participation in parts of adjudication material that is covered during my absence may be limited.

___ I understand that fundraising attempts will be made, however I am responsible for the full cost if no funds are raised.

___ I understand that a \$150 non-refundable deposit (due 7/1/25) is required to accept a spot on the team.

___ I understand that non-payment of any portion of the fees by certain deadlines may result in my/my child not being permitted to attend the Junior Theater Festival.

___ I agree to follow the Melody Lane Theatre mission statement, which is to celebrate the talents and successes of others and be a source of positivity to my castmates and creative team.

___ I understand that casting for the team is based on team casting, solos may be assigned later; which means that I recognize it is a privilege for my child to be chosen, as JTF is an ensemble experience. It is not about me/my student.

The following behaviors will result in immediate **Removal** from the Junior Theater Festival Team:

- Physical Violence
- Inappropriate Physical Contact
- Alcohol or Drug Use
- Vaping or Nicotine Use
- Vandalism to Melody Lane Property

I agree to follow these rules, procedures, and attendance policies and I understand the consequences of failing to do so. I will respect fellow cast-mates, crew members, staff members and property at all times.
