What are auditions like and how do I prepare?

Dancers will participate in a two-day audition process. The first day consists of across the floor technique that judges will score as well as learning 3 routines (jazz, pom, and contemporary). On the second day, judges will score dancers on each performance style and tabulate scores.

While dance experience is not a requirement to try out, previous team members have a dance background. Some skills to practice include leaps, triple pirouettes, 2 counts of 8 turns a la second, and battements.

What are practices like?

Practices for 2025–26 are held on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 7:30pm–10:30pm in the SDFC. During practice, the team drills technique, works on conditioning, prepares for performances, and does team bonding activities.

What performances do the Dancing Devils participate in?

The Dancing Devils have performed at a variety of venues including ASU Football Tailgates, ASU Homecoming Parade, Tempe's Oktoberfest, Diamondbacks games, the Arizona State Fair, UCLA v. ASU at the Rose Bowl, Walt Disney World, and more!

Are there leadership opportunities?

Aside from all the members having an active involvement volunteering for the local community, there are numerous leadership positions on this team. The team is entirely student led and the executive board consists of a President, Vice President, and Treasurer. Additionally, we have Team Admins who assist with tasks such as fundraising, social media, choreography, volunteering, etc.

What is the financial obligation?

Dues are \$325–\$350 a semester and cover fees to use our studio, uniforms, backpacks, and additional team gear. We also fundraise and use allocated funds from the university for other expenses (such as the Disney trip).
