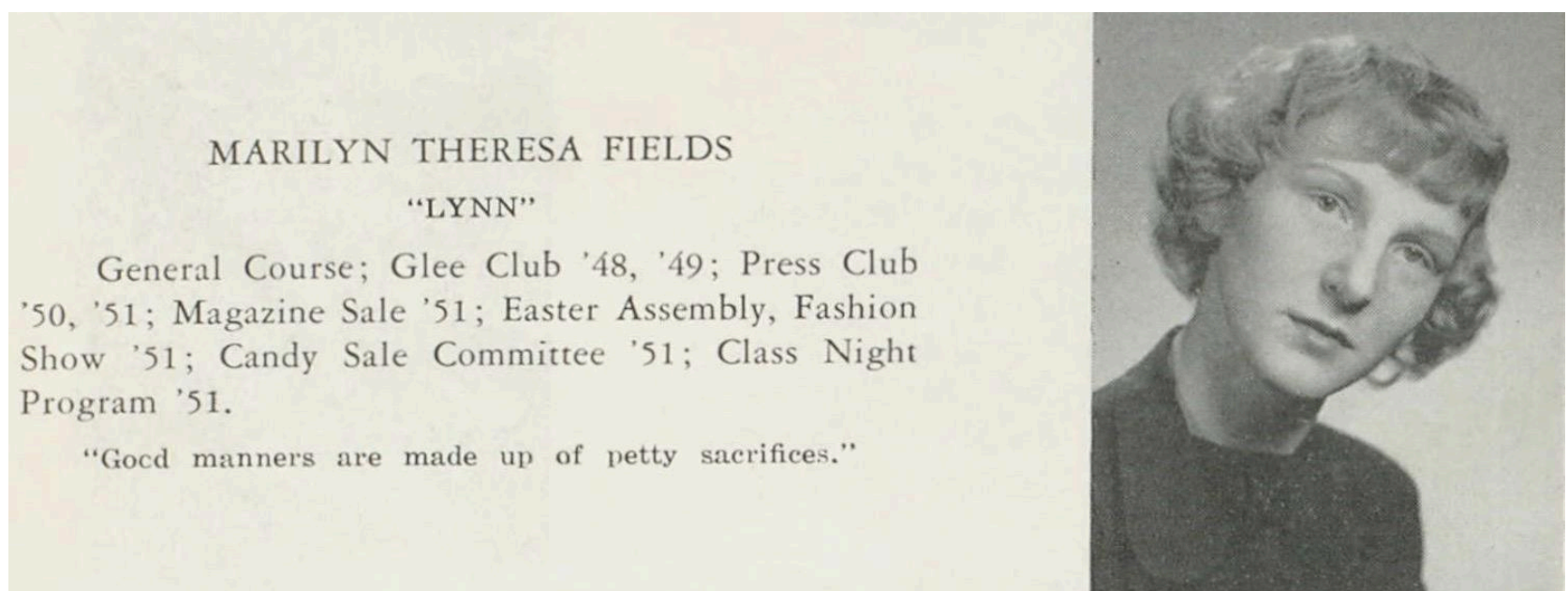


Marilyn Theresa Fields Whelden

Marilyn Fields Whelden was born on August 14, 1933 in Windsor Locks, Connecticut, to Arthur J. Fields and Mary Simmons Fields. She had four sisters – Patricia, Noreen, Eleanor, and Phyllis. Marilyn graduated from Windsor Locks High School in 1951. She lived in Broad Brook for most of her adult life.

Marilyn started working for Travelers Corporation right out of high school until 1954, when she took a position at The Connecticut Bank & Trust, where she spent the rest of her career. She started in Auditing at Arch Street and eventually transferred to Commercial Credit, ultimately becoming Supervisor in the CPA Confirmation area.
