Capital equipment, such as the garden boxes and tool shed, will continue to be maintained by the Vancouver School Board The school's gardening program provides students with valuable hands-on learning opportunities that connect directly to the BC curriculum, support healthy eating habits, and encourage environmental stewardship. Gardening activities also foster teamwork, responsibility, and outdoor engagement, which contribute positively to students' well-being and sense of belonging at school.

By committing to an annual allocation of \$1,000, the PAC ensures that the gardening program has a stable and predictable source of funding to cover essential consumable supplies and minor tools year after year. This ongoing investment will help the program remain sustainable and continue to thrive, while the VSB retains responsibility for maintaining capital infrastructure.

This annual allocation from Community Gaming Funds reflects the PAC's long-term commitment to enhancing student experiences at Simon Fraser Elementary, ensuring the garden remains a vibrant and educational resource for the school community.
