Sermon Notes

"Christ and the Fulfillment of the Law" Matthew 5:17-20

Big Idea: Jesus fulfilled the Law for us, freeing us from trying to earn righteousness and calling us to live in His grace.

1. The Law condemns heart-level sin (vs. 21-30)

2. The Law exposes our tendency to seek loopholes (vs. 31-42)

3. The Law shows our need for Christ (vs. 43-48).

Questions for Reflection:

- 1. In what areas of your life do you need to trust Jesus to transform your heart rather than trying to fix things on your own?
- 2. How can you actively pray for and love someone who has wronged or hurt you, as Jesus commands?
- 3. What does it look like to stop striving for perfection on your own and rest in Jesus' finished work?
