

WALS face-to-face 2029 conference host selection process

Having a face-to-face conference (FTFC) every other year and simultaneously a post-COVID growing interest in organising conferences is leading to some competition. WALS needs to make this competition transparent and benefit WALS and the quality of the conferences.

The following table presents the process in reverse chronological order.

Jan-Nov 2026	Expression of interest	Proposer to WALS repr. (WR)	See below.

The expression of interest is made 46 to 36 months before the expected FTFC (Jan-Nov 2026 for WALS2029). The proposer must be a WALS member and have the support of at least one Council member or be a Council member.

The expression of interest is made via a form ([LINK](#)). WR discusses the candidacy with the proposer and informs the other WALS officers and WALS ExCo. They publicise the expression of interest on WALS website (in the part that is reserved for members) in a table mentioning:

- Name of the proposer (and of the supporter if the proposer is not a Council member)
- Place/region of the proposed FTFC
- Possible dates of the FTFC
- A short argument (max 400 words) for the expression of interest.

In the interest of a choice respecting the collaborative spirit of WALS, the WR will inform each proposer of each existing interest and each new expression of interest.
