Privacy Policy December 22, 2023

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures for collecting, using and disclosing your information when you use the Services, and tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

We use your personal data to provide and improve services. By using the Services, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

1. Explanation and Definition

1.1 Explanation

Capitalized words have the meanings defined by the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning whether appearing in the singular or the plural.

1.2 Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- Affiliate Operator means an entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means an entity that owns 50% or more of the shares, equity or other rights to vote for directors or other governing bodies ownership of securities.
- Application means an operator-provided software program
- Operator (referred to in this Agreement as "Operator," "us," "us," or "our") means Whatsweb App for Whatsup.
- Device means any device that can access the Services, such as a computer, cell phone or digital tablet.
- Personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.
- Service means an Application.
- Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Operator. Refers to third-party operators or individuals employed by the Operator to facilitate the Service, provide the Service on behalf of the Operator, perform services related to the Service, or assist the Operator in analyzing the use of the Service.
- Usage Data means data that is collected automatically, whether generated through use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of page visits).
- You mean the individual accessing or using the Services, or the operator or other legal entity (as applicable) accessing or using the Services on behalf of that individual.

2. COLLECTION AND USE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA

2.1 Types of data collected

2.1.1 Personal data

When using our Services, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- Location
- Usage data
- 2.1.2 Usage data

Usage data is automatically collected when using the Services.

Usage Data may include your device's internet protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, pages of our Services you visit, time and date of your visit, time spent on those pages, unique device, etc. Information identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Services through or through your mobile device, we may automatically collect certain information, including but not limited to the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique ID, your mobile device's IP address, your mobile phone operation system, the type of mobile internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information sent by your browser when you visit our Services or access the Services through or through a mobile device.

2.2 Use of your personal data

The operator may use personal data for the following purposes:

- To provide and maintain our Services, including monitoring the use of our Services.
- Manage your account: Manage your registration as a user of the service. The personal data you provide may allow you to access different features of the service available as a registered user.
- For the performance of a contract: the formulation, compliance and commitment of a purchase contract for products, items or services you have purchased or any other contract you have with us through services.
- Contacting you: contacting you by email, phone call, text message or other equivalent form of electronic communication, such as push notifications from mobile applications regarding updates to features, products or contractual services (including security updates) or informational communications, Perform as necessary or reasonable.
- To provide you with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events from us that are similar to those you have purchased or inquired about, unless you have opted out of receiving such information.
- Manage your requests: participate in and manage your requests to us.
- For business transfers: We may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, reorganization, reorganization, dissolution or otherwise sell or transfer some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as a

bankruptcy, liquidation A portion, or similar program, in which the personal data we hold about users of our services is a transferred asset.

• For other purposes: We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotions and evaluating and improving our services, products, services, marketing and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

- With service providers: We may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our services in order to contact you.
- For business transfers: We may share or transfer your personal information in connection with any merger, sale of operator assets, financing or acquisition of all or part of our business to another operator or during negotiations.
- With affiliated operators: We may share your information with our affiliated operators, in which case we will require those affiliated operators to comply with this Privacy Policy. Affiliated operators include our parent operator and any other sub-operators, joint venture partners or other operators that we control or jointly control with us.
- With business partners: We may share your information with our business partners in order to offer you certain products, services or promotions.
- With other users: When you share personal information or otherwise interact with other users in public areas, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly posted externally.
- With your consent: We may disclose your personal information for any other purpose with your consent.

2.3 Retention of your personal data

The operator will only retain your personal data for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we need to retain your data to comply with applicable law), resolve disputes and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The operator will also retain usage data for internal analysis. Usage data is generally retained for a shorter period of time unless the data is used to enhance security or improve the functionality of our services, or we are legally obligated to retain the data for a longer period of time.

2.4 Transferring your personal data

Your information, including personal data, will be processed at the operator's operating offices and wherever other parties involved in the processing are located. This means that this information may be transferred to and stored on computers located outside your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction which may have different data protection laws than your jurisdiction.

Your agreement to this Privacy Policy and subsequent submission of such information constitutes your consent to this transfer.

The operator will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is processed securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and will not transfer your personal data to organisations or countries unless adequate controls are in place, including security of your data and other personal information.

2.5 Disclosure of your personal data

2.5.1 Commercial Transactions

Your personal data may be transferred if the operator is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale. We will give notice before your personal data is transferred and subject to different privacy policies.

2.5.2 Enforcement

In certain circumstances, the operator may be required to disclose your personal data if required by law or in response to a valid request from a public authority (such as a court or government agency).

2.5.3 Other legal requirements

The operator may disclose your personal data in good faith, believing that such action is necessary to:

- Compliance with legal obligations
- Protect and defend the rights or property of the operator
- Prevent or investigate possible misconduct in connection with the Services
- To protect the personal safety of service users or the public
- Prevent legal liability

2.6 Security of your personal data

The security of your personal data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we endeavour to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

3. Children's Privacy

Our services are not directed to anyone under the age of 13. We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13. If you are a parent or guardian and you know that your child has provided us with personal data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected personal data from anyone under the age of 13 without parental consent, we will take steps to delete that information from our servers.

If we require consent as a legal basis for processing your information and your country requires parental consent, we may ask for your parental consent before collecting and using that information.
