- **Objective – To allow Delaware Township residents an opportunity to be part of the 2023 March on Litter that was weather-cancelled**
 - **Reminder: this is a road side litter pick-up; please minimize work on any County road.**
- **Completion date:** December 11, 2023
- **Requirements:**
 - Minimum of 8 people, must have two adults, parent/guardian if children are under the age of 10 (or fourth grade).
 - One adult will be the leader and carry the leader backpack – **to be returned!**
 - Minimum of 2 (two) hours OR 2 (two) miles
 - Charity donations – maximum of \$75.00 per event, for two adults (\$150.00); \$200.00 for more than two adults – Place name and address of charity donation on the reverse side →→→
- **Other requirements:**
 - Dress for the weather and safety – sturdy footwear and long pants.
 - Layering is best, with long sleeves to protect against multi-flora rose.
 - Use sturdy gloves – these can be provided, let us know what you need.
 - Bring a water bottle.
 - **Please recycle the recycling in your recycling bin.**

Charity Donation

Per NJ Clean Community Guidelines, II. Allowable costs

13. Litter Cleanup and Removal, including:

a. Contributions to volunteer groups for community cleanup days or other authorized cleanups.

Contributions are limited to \$500 per volunteer group per event, location, acre or roadway mile. A road mile is defined as one side of the road. If a volunteer group cleans both sides of the road, the volunteer group cleans two miles.

For March on Litter, this contribution has been established to allow adults to chaperone groups on the road. Historically, the amount paid to chaperones has been \$75.00 per event, no greater than \$500.00 to a single group. For the reboot event, the cap will be set at \$200.00 per group.

Examples of local organizations are as follows: PiE (Partners in Education), DTAA, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, 4-H clubs, Church Groups, etc.
