Search for Scholarships in Naviance

- ☐ The Naviance link above will connect to *Naviance Student*
 - select the *Colleges* tab (at the top)
 - select *Scholarship Search*

Some scholarships allow students to pursue the scholarship independently and others require a committee to select a candidate.

- ☐ To learn more about a scholarship:
 - select the scholarship name, if interested, follow the directions
 - return to the scholarships list
 - check the box FAVORITE
- ☐ To identify a scholarship that requires you to **nominate** yourself for consideration:

- Go to Match & Filter
- Select *Scholarship Requirements*
- Click *Counselor Categories*
- *Self Nominate* from the drop down menu
- Click on the Google link to self nominate
- Fill out the Google Doc and check which scholarships you want to self-nominate yourself for

 - select *Favorite Scholarships*
