The purpose of this application packet is to outline the skill set of the Project SEARCH student candidate. This application enables the Selection Committee to properly assess each student candidate's skills, abilities and background. - 1. All students must have completed a referral to Nebraska VR <u>no later than April 5th, 2022, and met eligibility requirements.</u> If applicable, must have applied to the Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services Developmental Disabilities prior to August of 2022. If you need assistance please contact your Nebraska VR representative.
- 2. The student candidates will participate in an interview/skill assessment during the week of April 19th, time to be determined. They will interview with a Selection Committee represented by the various partners of Project SEARCH, which are: Hastings Public Schools, Mary Lanning Healthcare, Nebraska VR, and ESU 9.
- 3. If accepted into Project SEARCH, the student will receive written notification and an IEP will be developed with the IEP team for the 2022-23 school year.
- 4. If accepted, the student must be able to pass a drug screen and background check.

Entrance Criteria

- 1. Desire to be competitively employed in the community, at a minimum of 16 hours a week, at the conclusion of the Project SEARCH program
- 2. Must have the ability to work independently and complete tasks
- 3. In the last year of school eligibility
- 4. Has met all graduation requirements
- 5. Immunizations are current
- 6. Has a physical social security card and state ID
- 7. Has an IEP
- 8. Willing to organize and plan their own transportation to Mary Lanning Healthcare
- 9. Willing to attend Project SEARCH Job Club in August
- 10. Willing to comply with COVID-19 policies within HPS and Mary Lanning Healthcare. *Please note: Due to federal government regulations, everyone must have received the COVID-19 vaccine*

I, ______, understand that if I am accepted into the Project SEARCH program, I must abide by the following terms and conditions:

- I will complete at least three unpaid job rotations within the host business.
- I will attend the program every day from 8:30am- 2:30pm, Monday through Friday during the Hastings Public Schools academic calendar.
- I will dress appropriately and wear the required attire and protective gear for my job.
- I will call my instructor and departmental supervisors when I am absent or tardy.
- I will make up any time missed due to excused absences if asked to do so by the Job Coach or Teacher.
- I understand that I am responsible for transportation to Mary Lanning Healthcare.
- I will learn to use public transportation when available and if necessary.
- I will follow all the rules established by the program and host business.
- I will attend monthly meetings with my vocational rehabilitation counselor, parents, teachers, and business staff.
- I will schedule all appointments after Project SEARCH if possible.
- I will be an active participant and communicate any issues/concerns at our monthly meetings.
- At the completion of the program, I will receive my high school diploma.
- I will actively pursue competitive employment.
- If participating in extracurricular activities, I will be dismissed 15 minutes prior to the announcement time.
- I will participate in Project SEARCH Summer Program.
- I will comply with COVID-19 policies within HPS and Mary Lannning Healthcare. *Please note: Due to federal government regulations, everyone must have received the COVID-19 vaccine*
