#### Math with Ms. Adams

• Students are continuing to build understanding of systems of equations through word problems. We will focus on graphing and building visual representations to solve problems.

#### Science with Mrs. DiMarco

 Before the break students finished learning about evolution. Over the next few weeks, we will begin an in depth study of heredity and genetics. Students will learn about DNA, genes, chromosomes, punnett squares and genetic variation.

### Civics with Mr. Kennedy

• In Civics, students learned about key protests and Supreme Court cases of the Civil Rights Movement. Coming up students will close read the US Constitution to learn more about the founding and structure of our government.

### ELA with Ms. Whipple

• This week in ELA, students will complete their third common assessment. Next week, we will dive into the historical context surrounding our next text, *To Kill A Mockingbird*.

#### ESL with Ms. Garcia

• We have continued to work on our Personal Narrative Unit. Students started brainstorming ideas before break and will continue to work on their personal narratives this week.
