• Teacher Representative Update: Lindsay Hess

- Kids excited about music theater, PE, art, library
- Teachers said snacks have been amazing! Thank you for supporting us!
- LCMSD Trustee Update: Eric Schmautz
 - Recognized newly tenured teachers at last board meeting
 - Update on achievements that happened in summer school; impressive academic growth for participating students
 - No funding from district for summer school; looking at budget for next year to see if summer school is best use of funds
 - Jaime presented SPARK at last meeting
 - In middle school, shift to standards-based grading; kicked off in 2015, then break during Covid, and back this year.
 - Outside research group and Toni Brown leading; want to be sure students/parents are comfortable getting feedback on their students in this mode
 - Will continue to look at through end of this year
 - First look at CASPP results: slight dip in math/reading across district; uptick in science
 - Looking at how each student is progressing (comparing growth from grade to grade)
 - The Board made investments in interventions to ensure progress; now looking at which interventions worked best; also looking at iReady and feedback about interventions
 - Scores are in board docs; comparative data coming soon
