What should the landing page be?

- 1. Should convey that we are a big group of people who meet every month to talk all things python and software
- 2. Should showcase our video content in a way that makes people experience past events online
 - a. This will allow them to get a "taste" of it before attending
- 3. Should include the next event agenda in a clear and accessible location
- 4. Member's content should be accessible and featured somewhere below the fold
- 5. All of our important links should be easily found without taking away from the main message
 - a. The links should not distract people or grab their attention away
- 6. Should read like a short and very informative brochure
