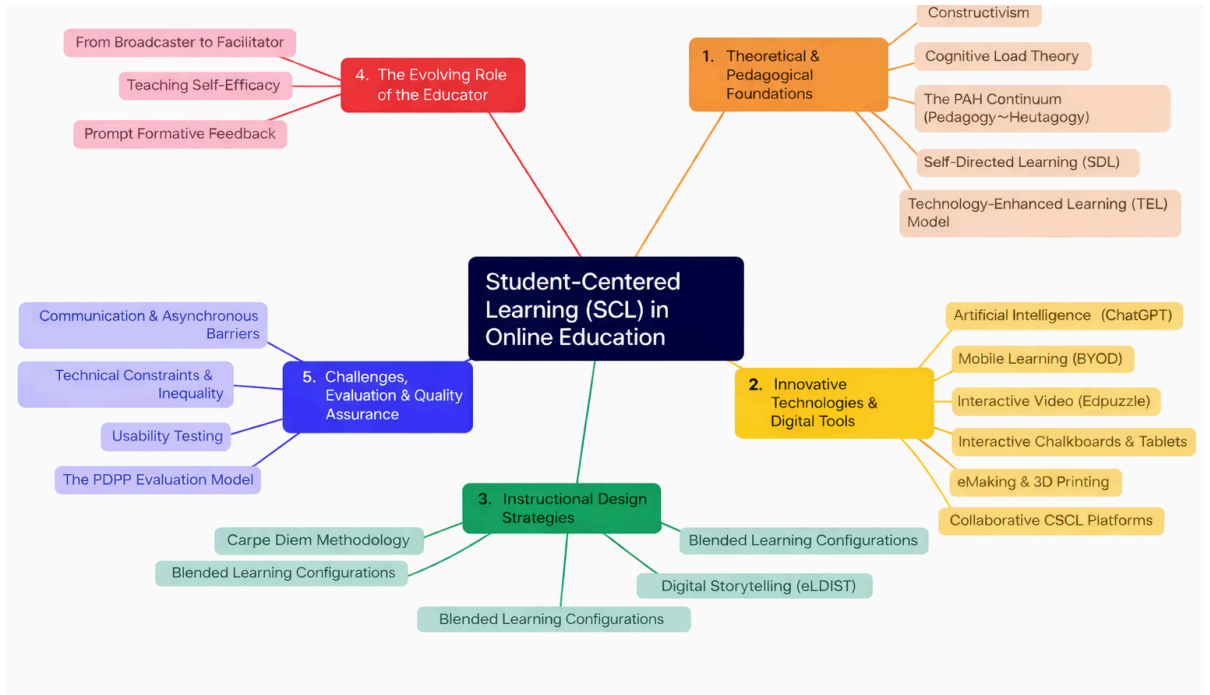


Figure 2.2 Literature review map

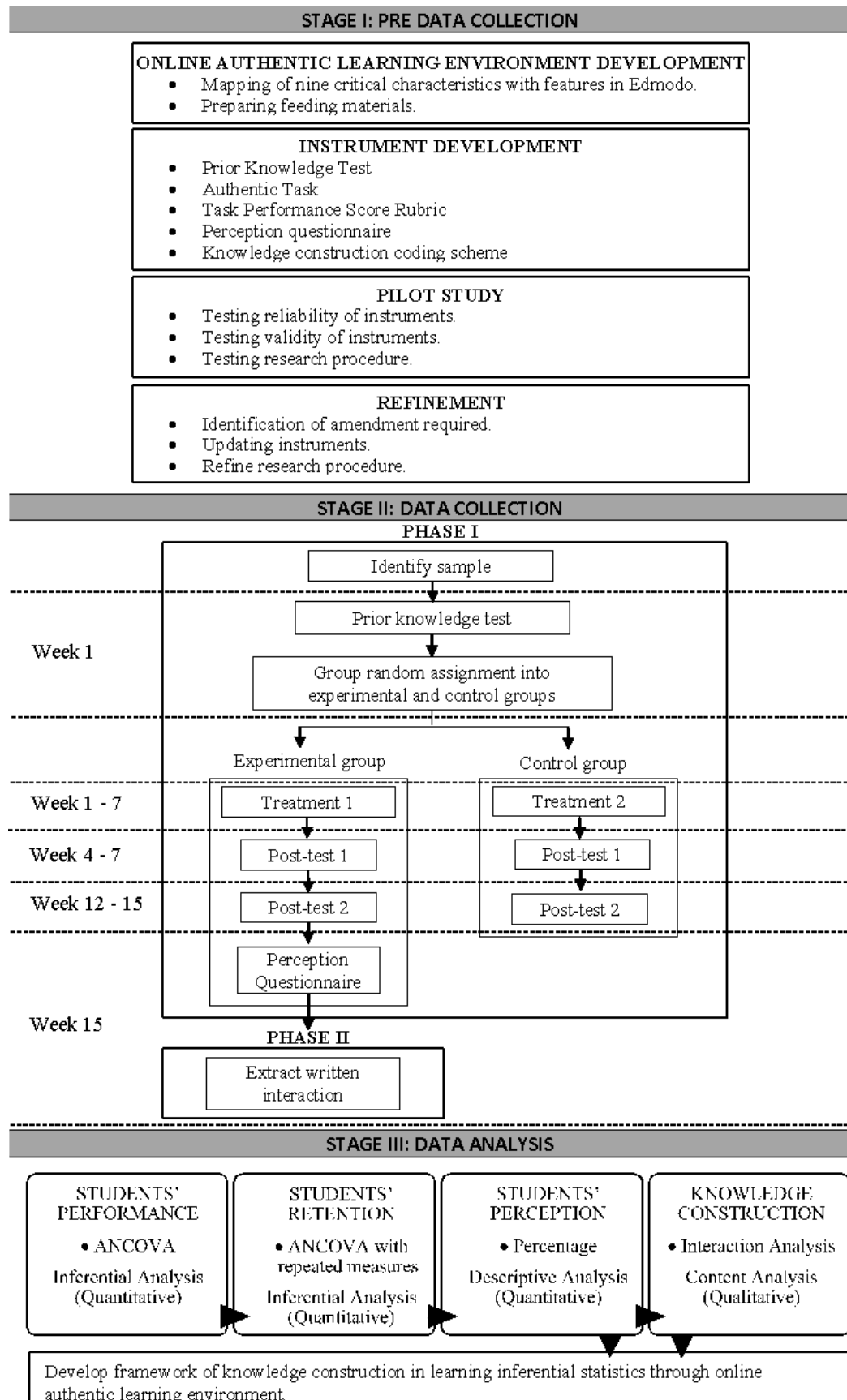


Figure 3.2 Research Procedure
