The past five years show a clear pattern of sustained improvement:

- **2020–21: 90.6%**
- **2021–22: 88.6%**
- **2022–23: 89.8%**
- **2023–24: 91.7%**
- **2024–25: 94.4%**

Lake County's 94.4% places the district:

- **+1.7 points higher than Orange County Public Schools (92.7%)**
- **+3.3 points higher than Osceola County Schools (91.1%)**
- **Tied with Seminole County Public Schools (94.4%)**
- **Within 1.0–1.2 points of high-performing neighbors Volusia (95.6%) and Sumter (95.4%)**
