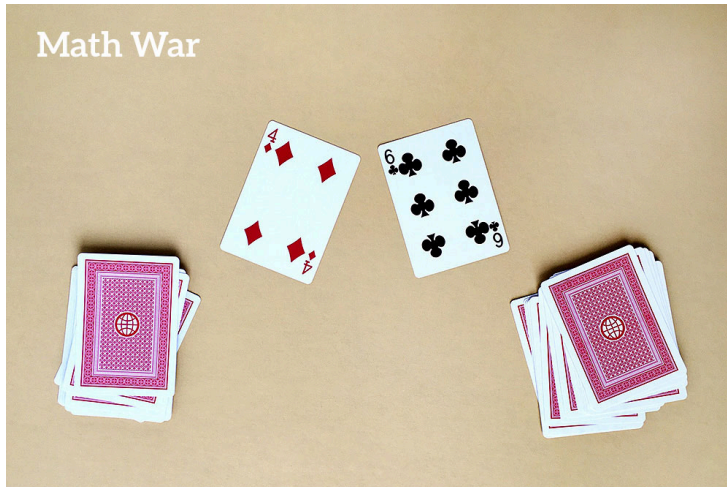


Ways to Practice Multiplication Facts

1. Math War



Here's how to play:

- Remove jokers, face cards, and aces from the deck. Split the deck evenly between two players. Make sure the cards are face down.
- Both players turn over the top card in their pile at the same time. Whoever yells out the complete math fact first wins the cards.
(Example: If the players turn over a 4 and a 6, whoever says "4 times 6 equals 24" first takes the cards.)
- The player who manages to get all of the cards is the winner.

Materials: set of dominoes, plain paper, pencil, partner to help check your work.

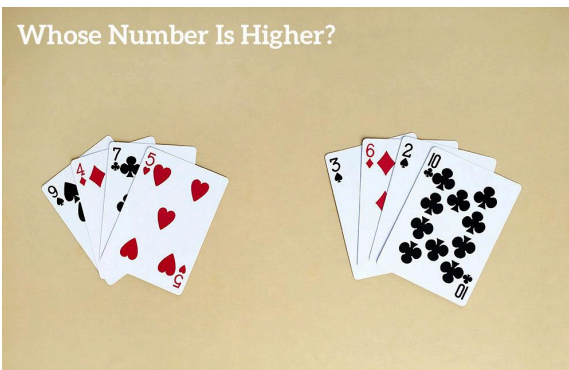
Directions:

3. Whose Number is Higher?



Here are the rules for this two-player game:

- First, decide on how many rounds you want to play. Then remove jokers, face cards, and aces from the deck. Deal out four cards to each player.
- The player who can make the highest product (for multiplication games) wins the round.
- Whoever wins the most rounds wins the game.
