Pilgrim Nervous Giggles is **IN TROUBLE**

Pilgrim Indecisive Scribble, always quick on her feet, locates the *Town* handy man and negotiates a mutually beneficial contract to expeditiously remedy the “Fountain Incident.”

Pilgrim Indecisive Scribble looks over forty plans for cutting-edge postmodern public art fountains with the handyman, not knowing that the town handyman is also busy with working on the dance hall and now has made a bad *impression* on the townspeople.

Pilgrim Indecisive Scribble is **IN TROUBLE**

Pilgrim Impatient Decider, predictably impatient, pulls a blueprint from the pile currently being examined by the town public arts council - now consisting of the bulk of the town's population - declares, “*IT’S MY FAVORITE*,” and begins digging.

Pilgrim Indecisive Scribble is **IN TROUBLE**

Parting the damp bunting, Pilgrim Impatient Decider realizes that the solution to his problems has been in front of him all along; this town needs a self-rimming fountain.

Pilgrim Lacy Curtains looks at Tony, hears his “girl,” and witheringly replies, “MONOCHROME,” revealing seven more yards of golden mustard bunting from which she will fashion an empire cut puffed sleeve couture SENSATION.
