- K/1 live drop-off drives straight (past the parking lot and PreK playground.)
- Continue to drive around the building (past the staff parking lot), around to the side of the building.
- Cars pull up along the sidewalk at the side of the building.

- Beginning at 8:45 am, students need to open the door and get out once along the marked area; do not wait for staff to open the vehicle door.
- Adults remain in the vehicle.
- Do not queue up before 8:30 am. Families accessing the Y Program need this entrance as well as staff arriving to work.
- At 8:55 (the official start time for K/1 students), if your vehicle is not in the queue, you will need to park in the front lot and walk your child to the office.

To promote a safe, efficient arrival for all:

- Say your goodbyes as you enter the school grounds.
- Have backpack ready at the student's feet.
- **Do not** pass other vehicles.

PreSchool

- PreSchool families turn left and park in the front lot.
- Walk with your preschooler(s) using the crosswalk to the PreK arrival location at the PreK playground entrance.
- Buses turn left and unload at the front of the school.

We appreciate your help to ensure we begin the day safely and efficiently. We welcome approximately 600 students each morning. Following the group plan helps everyone.
