2. The student must be a New York State resident.
3. The logo must reflect the theme of the conference.
4. The logo must be scalable and must render well in color as well as grayscale.
5. The logo can be created digitally or by using pen, marker, colored pencil, or any other appropriate medium.
6. Students may submit more than one entry if they wish.

The logo is the student's original work and includes no copyrighted or otherwise protected information material other than the NYS TESOL logo, if used.

The student understands that, upon submission, the conference logo becomes the property of NYS TESOL.
