

Objectives:

- Evaluate how events in America's history have affected housing design.
- Compare and contrast housing styles in the 18<sup>th</sup> century.
- Compare and contrast housing styles in the 19<sup>th</sup> century.
- Evaluate historical housing elements that influenced 20<sup>th</sup> century signs
- Analyze the unique housing designs of the late 20<sup>th</sup> and early 21<sup>st</sup> century.

Directions:

Step 1) As a class we will be creating a timeline to identify major events in American History and characteristics of American architecture. Each student will be assigned an architecture style to create a digital poster with the following requirements:

- Title (The title should identify the architecture style.)
- Illustration of architecture style
- Description of the architecture style (The details do matter - ie- roof style, pediments, etc...)
- Identify the time period and estimated dates
- Identify the historical events that influenced this architecture style and explain why
- Digital format
